The SHOC Foundation is excited to announce the 3rd Annual Drive Out Ovarian Cancer Golf Tournament. Proceeds are funneled directly to a research team focusing on genetic causes of Ovarian Cancer at the OHSU Knight Cancer Institute, one of the nation's leading research centers and the only facility of its kind in Oregon. Ovarian Cancer impacts 1 out of 69 women. Of the 25,000 women diagnosed this year in the USA, approximately 15,000 are expected to die from this disease.

Sherie Hildreth was diagnosed with Ovarian Cancer in October of 2004. This life-altering event motivated her to create the Sherie Hildreth Ovarian Cancer (SHOC) Foundation, which was designed to promote education and research for the prevention and cure of this disease. In the following years, Sherie was tireless in her work for the Foundation's efforts. Sherie Hildreth died from Ovarian Cancer in December of 2009.

Heidi Moore Angell was diagnosed with Ovarian Cancer in June of 2008. She wanted to do something to fight back and dreamed of a benefit golf tournament to raise awareness and provide funding for research. Heidi and Sherie met through mutual involvement with other Ovarian Cancer survivors. Together they shared the vision to increase awareness and early detection of Ovarian Cancer, as well as raise funds for research of the disease. Heidi channeled her support through Sherie's Foundation, and today, Bruce Hildreth continues Sherie's efforts in leading the Foundation and keeping the dream alive.

This year's tournament will be held **Friday, September 23, 2011** at Colwood National Golf Club in honor of Heidi Moore Angell. The day will start with a light breakfast, followed by 18 holes of golf. A buffet lunch will be provided, as well as a silent auction and raffle. This tournament is a wonderful opportunity to share in a great time while making a substantial contribution to a worthwhile cause.

The SHOC Foundation is a 100% volunteer operated organization. In six years, the foundation has donated over \$300,000 directly to the Gynecologic Cancer research lab headed by Dr. Tanja Pejovic, M.D., PhD at the Oregon Health & Science University Knight Cancer Institute. In its two years running, the golf tournament has accounted for \$31,000 of this amount. This year's goal is to raise \$20,000.
