### OVARIAN CANCER SYMPTOMS

- Abdominal pressure, bloating, swelling or discomfort
- Nausea, loss of appetite
- Unusual fatigue
- Abnormal vaginal bleeding
- Unexplained weight gain or loss
- Urinary frequency, constipation or diarrhea

See your gynecologist if these symptoms are unusual for you and occur almost daily for more than a few weeks. Experts suggest a combination of a pelvic/rectal exam, CA 125 blood test and a transvaginal ultrasound.
